

#### **GOP Leadership Lack**

The Republican governors' unhappiness that they are not in full command—a condition openly voiced at the National Governors Conference last -has deeper roots than are being acknowl-

The decision of the GOP Governors Associa-The decision of the GOT GOVERNOR ASSOCIA-tion to meet twice yearly beginning next December reflects the immediate grumbling over the ineffec-tuality of this organization gince it was given real life and visibility 19 months ago at Denver just after Barry Goldwater's defeat for the presidency.

Many of the Republican governors indicate anany or the Republican governors induced they want the controlling role in the choosing of the party's next presidential candidate, the shaping of its platform and the steady offering of interim party positions on the major issues.

But talks among these governors and some of their key lieutenants suggest that merely shooting adrenalin into the feeble Governors Association will not turn the trick. What they need in their stable are more and better horses.

Their present number-17-is seen by several leaders as inadequate to cast commanding weight in Republican councils. When they last rted decisive influence, in the presidential nomination of Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower in 1952, their company totaled 25. After his election they were 30 strong. They have not been so rous since.

A few leaders here argue that numbers are not important so long as the party has governors— as it does now—in such big states as New York, Pennsylvania, Ohio and Michigan. But others

The point of having healthy numbers is that any leadership provided by a nucleus of big-state any leadership provided by a nucleus of ing-state governors can be quickly translated into an effec-tive and possibly commanding party coalition simply by calling upon like-minded, problem-solv-ing governors in states all around the map. With-out those numbers, the chiefs may have too few

Yet the thinness of their ranks is not the sole root cause of Republican governors' present frus-tration and distress. The truth, quietly conceded by some, is that the ingredients of real leadership are lacking—and have been for some years.

When Republican governors did a job for Eisenhower in 1952, they had no association, no Eisennower in 1952, they had no assectation, in regular common meetings, no strategy of coalition. But they were led by Gov. Thomas E. Dewey of New York and his celebrated strategist, Herbert Brownell. A tougher pair of convention delegate rustlers seldom has been seen on the Republican

The one thing those 1952 governors did in concert—the approval at the Houston Governors Conference of a resolution supporting a crucial Eisenhower convention tactic-was engineered by Dewey and Brownell. Moreover, they set up the situation that made the tactic possible at all.

Any cursory newspaper reader can be excused for thinking that Food and Drug Administration Commissioner James Goddard's only responsi-bility is regulating the drug industry. Practically all of Goddard's headline-making actions have involved some sort of crackdown on drugs.

But Goddard has not exactly neglected the food industry in his six months on the job. Roughly two-thirds of FDA's activities involve food in

monellosis. Named for the pathologist who discovered the bacteria (not for the Pacific Northwest's pink fish), salmonellosis is an extremely painful—but not generally fatal—type of poisoning.

Symptoms, which ordinarily begin eight to 8 hours after the infecting organism is taken into the system, are nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain, diarrhea, headache and chills.

About 20,000 cases are reported in the United States each year. Nearly 100 are fatal.

But, as Goddard notes, these statistics are gross understatements. Perhaps as many as 400,000 case go unreported each year, a good part of them scratched off as "intestinal fu."

The bitter, destructive riots on Chicago's West Side produced the inevitable sober-sided conferences between city officials and top Negro

ises of faster action on better jobs, education and housing for Negroes. Mayor Richard Daley pledged more recreation space for the afflicted area, and sprinkler systems for the fire hydrants, whose illegal tapping on a sweltering day had touched off the riots. A committee study of police and community relations was announced.

Yet neither Daley nor the circuit-riding Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. nor Chicago civil rights leader Albert Raby dealt with some of the deepest aspects of this minor civil war. They are seldom

As they pertain to the specifics of self-defeating Negro attitudes and behavior in distressed hard attention needs to be paid first to the effect of America's flooding affluence on the millions of

Five years ago it suddenly became fashionable to talk of the "invisible poor." But from the viewpoint of the poor, the important thing is not that they are unseen but that the affluent world around them is so highly visible to them—so close within reach and yet so unattainable.

We live in a society which almost literally tries to cram affluence down the citizen's throat.

This constantly enlarging stress on material il-being, advanced at obvious cost to other hum values, lies at the root of Negro impatience—in values, lies at the root of Negro impatience—can be considered to the constant of the constant man values, lies at the root of Negro impatiencewhich is really the governing factor here in Chicago, in Watts, in Brooklyn's Bedford-Stuyvesant

It is silly to argue that Negroes are impatient cause they have waited 100 years for the fulfillment of their rights. Most of the militant protesters have been on this earth less than a quarter of that time. They know the struggles of the past

What they do know first-hand is the richness of American life visible in gleaming automobiles passing down their streets, in the beckoning cornucopia of the markets, in handsome new houses and

furbished sectors of central cities only compounds their frustration. For Negroes have inherited the core of central cities which, in their original maketruly livable places. And today those cores are bad-

Worse still, these central cities now stand out as never before in painful contrast to the swelling, prosperous suburbs—the image of the new and the desirable, where space and greenness are tangible

It is not simply that Negroes need "better housing." Chicago, ironically, is noted by building code specialists as having one of the best and

code specialists as having one of the best and toughest building inspection and code enforcement setups in the nation. It is vastly superior, for example, to New York City's.

What Negroes want is what the suburbs connote in every way.
