

They pale to nothing when compared to the draft evasion prevalent during the Civil War, when the very existence of the nation was in danger.

Yet history may decide otherwise than we think as to who is best serving the interests of future Americans, and of humanity at large — those who go to war without question or those who resist a war they consider "unjust and immoral" even to the point of disgrace and imprisonment.

Certainly a nation of pacifists would not bring a change of he art among the Communits. It might well set the stage for even more death and oppression than are currently being wisted upon that one unfortunate land.
