When the Salk vaccine was revealed to the world in 1955, it was not as a rumor leaked to the press but a formal announcement backed up by years of painstakingly compiled clinical evidence.

The existence of the vaccine could have been made. known long before, when researchers first realized they we're on to something. An unknown number of lives could have been saved or disabilities prevented if medical authorities had decided to forego the accepted testing procedures and take a chance on immediate mass innoculations.


But think of the tragedy if the vaccine had not proved out, of the thousands of parents who would have been false hope, the hundreds of children who might have been harmed by unforeseen toxic effects.

There is a difference, of course, between a vaccine designed to prevent a disease in children who do not have it and one aimed at curring or retarding a disease in adults who are already dying of it.

The noted historian, Henry Steele Commager, testifying before the Senate Foreign Relations Committee the other day, warred that the United States has overextended itself as a world power because of a "imvaliation bession" with communism and a "messianic" belief in our obligation to keep global peace, stop aggression wherever it appears upon the world.

It is doubtful that he would recommend that we abolish foreign aid, which is already down to a mere shadow of its former self, or the Peace Corps, or any of the numerous American programs for building the economics of foreign nations. What then should we do?

Should we remove our divisions from Europe? But West Germany would scream and Britain would undergo a parliamentary crisis. We can't remove any troops from Latin America or Africa because we don't have any there.

Should we disentantle ourselves from such alliances as NATO, CENTO and SEATO? But Charles de Gaulle has already pretty well taken care of the former and the latter never 'really existed except on paper.

Should we make friends with China?-But if the Russians couldn't do that, it is unlikel, that we can, especially during China's current steps of national schizophrenia.

In what ways are we intolerant or misusing

In what ways are we intolerant or misusing our immense power with the new nations? The professor didn't say.
