Last March a Sunday newspaper magazine supplement invited readers to return a ballot indicating their views about changing the dates of certain nonreligious holidays so that they would occur regularly on Mondays. It reported a deluge of returns—180,061 in favor, only 10,004 opposed.

A few months before that, the U.S. Chamber of Commerce polled its members on the question and found an overwhelming 85 per cent approved Most of the businessmen said the change would help their production and work schedules by avoiding the stop-start interruptions caused by mid-
